

Guide to Using the Library for Albany Students

Accessing Library Collections

There are two ways to access items within the UWA Library Collections:

1. OneSearch - <https://www.uwa.edu.au/library/OneSearch>
2. Via your Unit Readings –within the UWA LMS Learning Management System - <https://lms.uwa.edu.au/>

OneSearch UWA Library Catalogue	Unit Readings in the LMS
<p>This is the main way to search and access the UWA Library resources. Our collection includes books, journals, magazines, newspapers, audio-visual materials, and large database platforms with specialist subject content and search terms.</p> <p>A significant part of the collection is available online, fully accessible from home when you log in to OneSearch with your student number and pHEME password.</p> <p>Students and staff can also request physical items from our Perth based library collections through OneSearch.</p> <p>For further information: https://www.uwa.edu.au/library/Help-and-support/Using-OneSearch</p>	<p>The Unit Reading platform is used by your Unit Coordinators to share any required and recommended references for your unit. You will find a link to Unit Readings within each of the units you are enrolled in.</p> <p>The references in the reading list will link you to items available through OneSearch or out to other external online resources on the Internet. The UWA Albany Campus holds a discrete collection of physical library items available for loan by regional staff and students only. You will need your student card to borrow items from the collection. Students can borrow an unlimited number of items. Loan periods are generally for a semester, unless the item is recalled by another student.



- **To renew your loan**, go to the Library website (<https://uwa.edu.au/library>) and click 'My Library Account' under the search bar. In the loans section you can view your due dates and renew the loan period. Your library account area is also available when logged into OneSearch.

- To request items held in other UWA Libraries login to OneSearch, search for the required item, navigate to the 'Find & Request' section to request the item. You will need to select Albany Campus as the pickup location. Items will be delivered and returned via the Albany Campus. Delivery will usually take 2 to 3 days if the item is available.

Regional postgraduate students have the option to request items to be sent to your home address via Express Post. Requested items can be returned to the Library using the prepaid satchel included with the sent item.

- Any UWA students may recall an item on loan. If an item you have borrowed is recalled, you will receive an email notification and will need to ensure the item is returned back to the Albany Campus or another UWA Library within 15 days.
- The Library will communicate with you about your loans and requests through your UWA email address.
