Title and brief description	GEOSM506 Teaching Outdoors. This micro-credential aims to introduce primary or secondary school teachers and educators to the wealth of opportunities for incorporating outdoor learning activities into teaching aspects of science and humanities disciplines. The micro-credential combines online materials and discussions with a 1-day field excursion and project-based learning to explore the links between earth science and other natural sciences, history and urban planning.
