Title and brief description	PSYCM502 Considerations for Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) Diagnosis. This micro-credential will provide students with foundational knowledge required for understanding FASD. This will include covering the basic characteristics of FASD, relevant barriers and consequences of assessment and diagnosis, and forms of intervention which may be helpful for people with FASD. Students completing both 1) History and Basic Characteristics of FASD and 2) Considerations for FASD Diagnosis may be eligible to complete the Graduate Certificate in the Diagnosis and Assessment of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (cc: 73260), which will provide clinicians with the skills required for conducting assessments for which FASD is a differential.
